

Right Angle Weave (RAW)

Each new round of beads is indicated by a different color.

Follow the numerical order shown.

Remember clockwise/counter clockwise.....clockwise/counter clockwise.....etc. ...etc...etc...

Tension: Nice firm tension but don't pull too tight. You want to maintain the cross shapes.

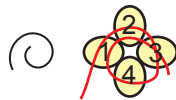
Don't let the clockwise/counter clockwise stuff scare you. Just remember that if you ALWAYS reenter the bead you came out of on the opposite side when adding a new unit you will be doing it right.

This is one needle RAW. Some people prefer two needles. Take a look at page 1.

The two needle ladder stitch (done with 1 bead at a time) should get you started.

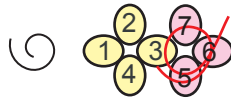
The only difference is that you pick up more beads with RAW.

1: clockwise
1, 2, 3, 4, 1, 2, 3



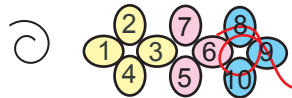
1: String the first 4 beads and tie in a circle.
Leave a tail (weave this in later)
As shown, re-enter 1, 2 & 3

2: counter CW
5, 6, 7, 3, 5, 6



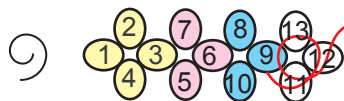
2: Pick up 5, 6 & 7. Re-enter 3, 5 & 6

3: CW
8, 9, 10, 6, 8, 9



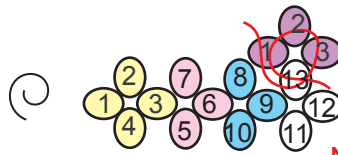
3: Pick up 8, 9 & 10. Re-enter 6, 8 & 9

4: counter CW
11, 12, 13, 9, 11, 12



4: Pick up 11, 12 & 13. Re-enter 9, 11, 12

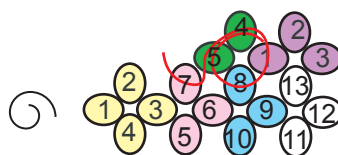
5: (new row) CW
enter 13, pick up
1, 2, 3, reenter 13, 1



5: Pick up 1, 2 & 3. Re-enter 13 & 1

NOTE: New rows can be added on top or bottom.

6: counter CW
4, 5, pass through
8, 1, 4, 5, 7



6: Pick up 4 & 5. Re-enter 8, 1, 4, 5 & 7
From this point on until the end of each row
you will pick up 2 beads.
clockwise/counter clockwise.....
At the start & end of each new row you will
pick up 3 beads.
